Rules for Year End Awards

(revised Dec. 2010)

- **To qualify for Class Year-End Awards, the exhibitor must show at a minimum of 3 events*. The horse owner and exhibitor must BOTH be current members of Oklahoma Paint Horse Club at the time of the show. Points accumulated prior to being current members will not count towards the year-end awards. Membership period is from Jan 1st to Dec 31st.**
- **Land Rush Weanlings do not have to be shown at additional events* during the show season to qualify for year-end awards. The weanling with the most points will be deemed the winner.**
- **Participation Points (1 point per Judge) will be awarded for those exhibitors who do *not* place on the Judge's card.**
- **Division winners are determined by the total number of points earned by the horse/exhibitor combination (corresponding Halter classes per division are required). In the case of two Youth showing the same horse in two divisions, the youth which exhibits the horse in halter will be given the points.**
- **Divisions are defined as:**
 - **Novice Youth (18&Under)**
 - **Walk/Trot Youth (5-9)**
 - **13 & Under Youth**
 - **14-18 Youth**
 - **Youth (18 & Under) All Breed**
 - **Novice Amateur**
 - **Walk/Trot Amateur**
 - **Amateur**
 - **Amateur All Breed**
 - **Open (includes Halter Color classes)**
 - **Open All Breed**

- ***The definition of an event is as follows:**
 - **Jan 1, 2, 3 counts as ONE event (considered the January Holiday Classic show)**
 - **April 2-day show counts as ONE event**
 - **August 2-day show counts as ONE event**
 - **Land Rush show (APHA classes only) count as ONE event**
 - **Dec 29, 30, 31 counts as ONE event (considered the December Holiday Classic show)**

- **Ties for year-end awards will be broken by counting the number of First places awarded during the season. If still tied, then the exhibitor/horse combination with the most Second places will win and so on until the tie is broken.**

- **OPHC Club Point Calculations:**
The number of points earned is determined by the following illustration:

- **Any person issuing any type of insufficient funds to OPHC will be disqualified from receiving class points or year-end awards earned during the season. Points will be reinstated if the funds are paid in full within 30 days of the show. This person shall be allowed to show the remainder of the offending season and the following entire season on a cash basis only unless they appeal to the Board of Directors and are granted permission to pay via check again.**
- **It is the Owner's responsibility to notify the point recorder if a change in ownership occurs during the season.**
